TEPF Goal

To promote continuity of telecommunications services in New Zealand by:

- providing a forum for discussion of national telecommunication emergency planning issues; including
- developing and maintaining an agreed and wellfunctioning capability for emergency response.



TEPF: Conducting Business

- Chatham House Rules apply
- Individuals represent their employer and participate in their own right
- Meets quarterly
- Minimum of formality
- Decisions by consensus
- Activities may include:
 - disseminating information on issues within the Forum's sphere of expertise.
 - coordination of responses to government requests for information and support on emergency management issues.
- Convene as required to facilitate emergency response activity


During an Emergency: NEAT

National Emergency Alert for Telecommunications

- Developed by the TEPF
- Consists of conference calls between appropriate TEPF members
- May be triggered by a range of event types
- Preference to activate NEAT and then stand down rather than a situation developing before acting

NEAT: Agenda

- Roll call and basic protocols
- Briefly describe the causing event
- Network situation
- Requests for assistance
- Determine subsequent meetings

Responsibilities

- Chair:
 - Regional event: CDEM GEOC Lifelines Utility
 Coordinator
 - National event: NCMC Lifelines Utility Coordinator
- NEAT Initiator: any member of TEPF can initiate the NEAT process.
- Attendees: Appropriate representatives of TEPF members
