Who is IPWEA NZ?



- The Institute of Public Works Engineering Australasia New Zealand Division
- Brief history:
 - ALGENZ formed 1989
 - Renamed INGENIUM in 2001.
 - Became IPWEA NZ in June 2013
- Membership: Over 900 in NZ; LG staff (50%), Consultants, Contractors, others.
- Incorporated society
- All public works: water, waste, transport, energy, comms, rec assets and property

What's Hot?...30 Year Strategies



- LGA amended in Aug 2014
- New requirement for 30 yr core infrastructure strategies
 - Reinforces the importance of asset management planning as part of a council's prudent stewardship of resources
 - Requires councils to prepare an infrastructure strategy
 - for at least a 30 year period,
 - Include in long-term plans from 2015
 - Requires councils to disclose risk
 management arrangements, such as
 insurance, for physical assets in their annual
 reports.






LGA amendment...continued

New Zealand Lifelines

- Infrastructure Strategy workshop (see also handout)
- Must id and manage risks from natural hazards
 - Must show financial provisions for managing risks. Check out our NAMS insurance guidelines:

- Lifelines projects and groups an essential part of solution







