The Chatham Islands have always been under pressure and not had

sufficient capacity to deliver. Over time I have been spending less time doing tasks that a Group Manager/Controller should be doing just to get the work done. The issue came to a head during lock down and I could only have my CDC manager assisting me, we did everything including unloading freight trucks, repacking food boxes to cater to the large numbers in homes and delivery.

With the increase in responsibilities and expectations from Central, Regional, Local government, Iwi/Imi and community there is an urgent need to analyse these needs against CDEM capability and determine what resources are needed to build capacity to meet these expectations.

This tool is to help identify what capability level the CDEM Group emergency management is currently working at, and where it needs to be for optimal efficiency. To identify what resources are needed to build capacity to optimal efficiency level and a timeframe to reach that level. This tool can also be used by NEMA as a start to monitor and evaluate all group capability levels and support were needed.
