## Project description

The Welfare Response trailer can also be used as a public education tool to take to open days, and other public events. The trailer will have CDEM branding.

During an emergency event, welfare of affected communities is an essential requirement. The Canterbury Earthquake demonstrated that welfare to affected communities is critical in ensuring that they are looked after and to reduce suffering. The Welfare Response trailer will provide an enhanced response capability within the Region.

CDEM is not always well represented in the public eye, and misses opportunities for positive exposure at public events. The Welfare Response trailer will help raise community awareness by promoting the CDEM messages (Get Ready, Get Thru, What's the Plan Stan?').
