Additional business support announced.

Sustained high interest in special recovery visa category

The Recovery Visa (a Specific Purpose Work Visa) is for migrant workers who can assist with the recovery. There has continued to be high demand for recovery visas. The visa is being processed as a priority (currently, on average, within five working days) and successful applicants are refunded the application fee.

Strong levels of critical materials, ready to support recovery

There are strong stock levels of critical building materials, including a strong range of alternative product. This will allow faster rebuilding as existing supply should be able to meet demand.

Building material inflation halved

Building material price inflation has halved over the past six months and is expected to stabilise further as global pressures lessen and inventories continue to be well stocked.
