Immigration New Zealand

- 95 per cent of Recovery Visas have been decided. On average, INZ processes Recovery Visa applications in six weekdays, with approved applications taking an average of five weekdays.
- RSE workers continue to move between the impacted regions and others throughout the country. This represents seasonal trends and is now unlikely a significant consequence the extreme weather events.

New Zealand Claims Resolution Service (NZCRS)

- Full and final settlements are being presented to whanau in the Hawke's Bay and Tairāwhiti regions. NZCRS are providing assistance to ensure whanau are receiving their policy entitlements.

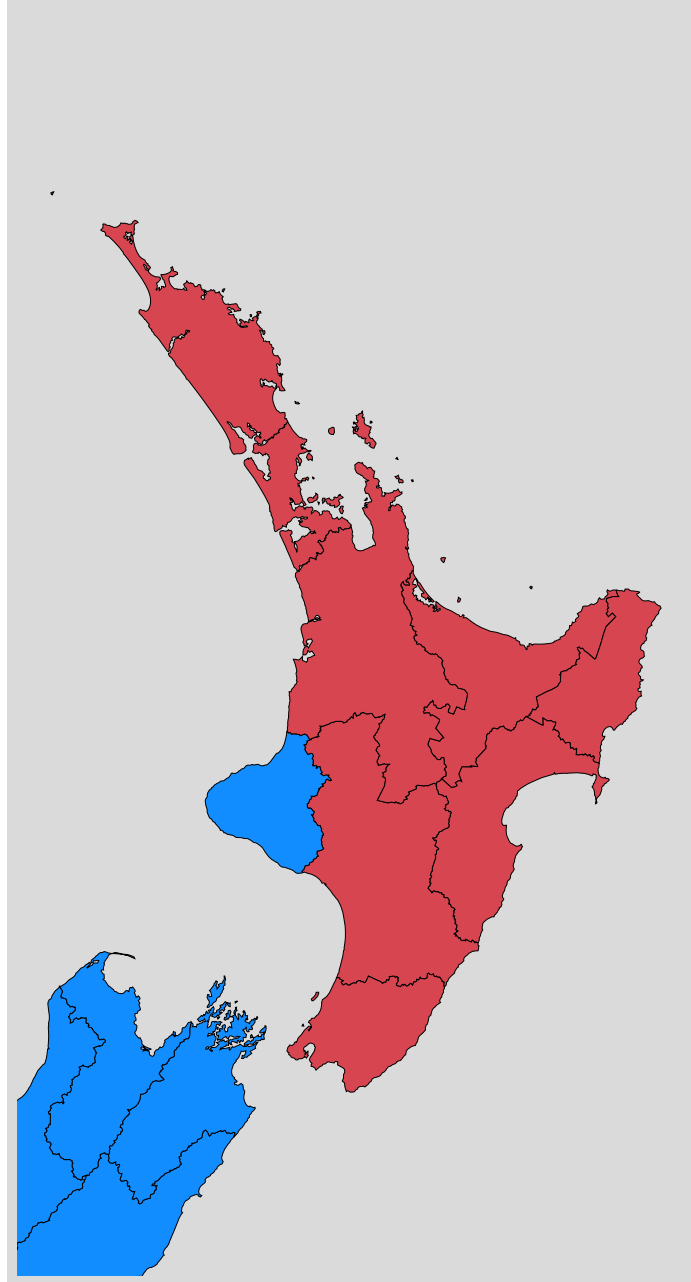
