The data presented on this page only includes data that relates to regions that have been affected by the weather events of January and February 2023. These are indicated by the red regions on the map. "As at first date (second date)" is used to denote the current (first) and previous (second) report dates for comparison purposes. Yellow denotes the current period's value, (white) denotes the previous.

MBIE's work touches on many aspects of everyday life, so the severe weather events earlier this year led to a quick response from many parts of the organisation.

MBIE's response has been focused on assisting those affected through several initiatives:

- Providing advice to affected tenants, landlords, employers, and employees.
- Launched the New Zealand Claims Resolution Service (NZCRS) to help meet an expected increase in insurance claims.
- Activated and are scaling up the Temporary Accommodation Service (TAS) to support those who have been displaced with housing.

- Implemented a new Recovery Visa category to make it easy to bring much-needed assistance to New Zealand.
- Co-ordinated additional Rapid Building Assessment support and deployment of Rapid Building Assessors (RBA) from the national register.

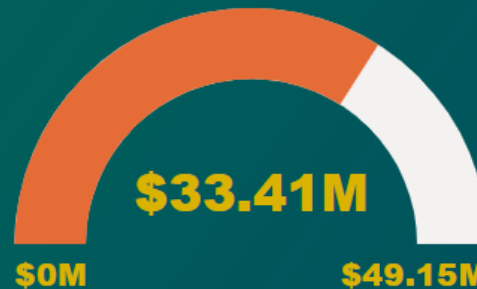

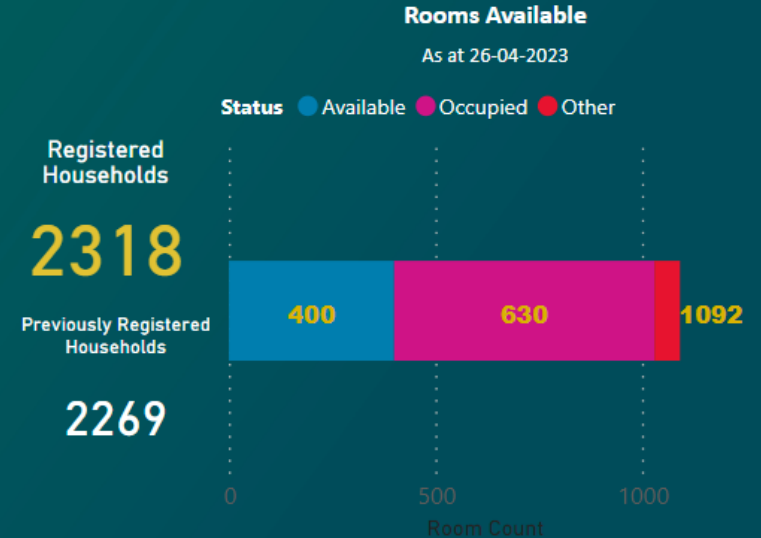
